3 - pre-requisites (accounting, statistics, economics)	1 Methodology course	Seminar in Business Management (SBM)
3 other core courses		

Note: If more than 8 courses taken, they count as electives.

Exemptions

- If students choose to exempt the pre-requisite courses
- They must be replaced with **CORE COURSES**

Elective Courses

- Students need **7** elective courses

3 courses in one major	4 other elective courses
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It is possible to earn a double major. Requirements are:

3 courses in one major	3 courses in 2nd major	1 other elective course

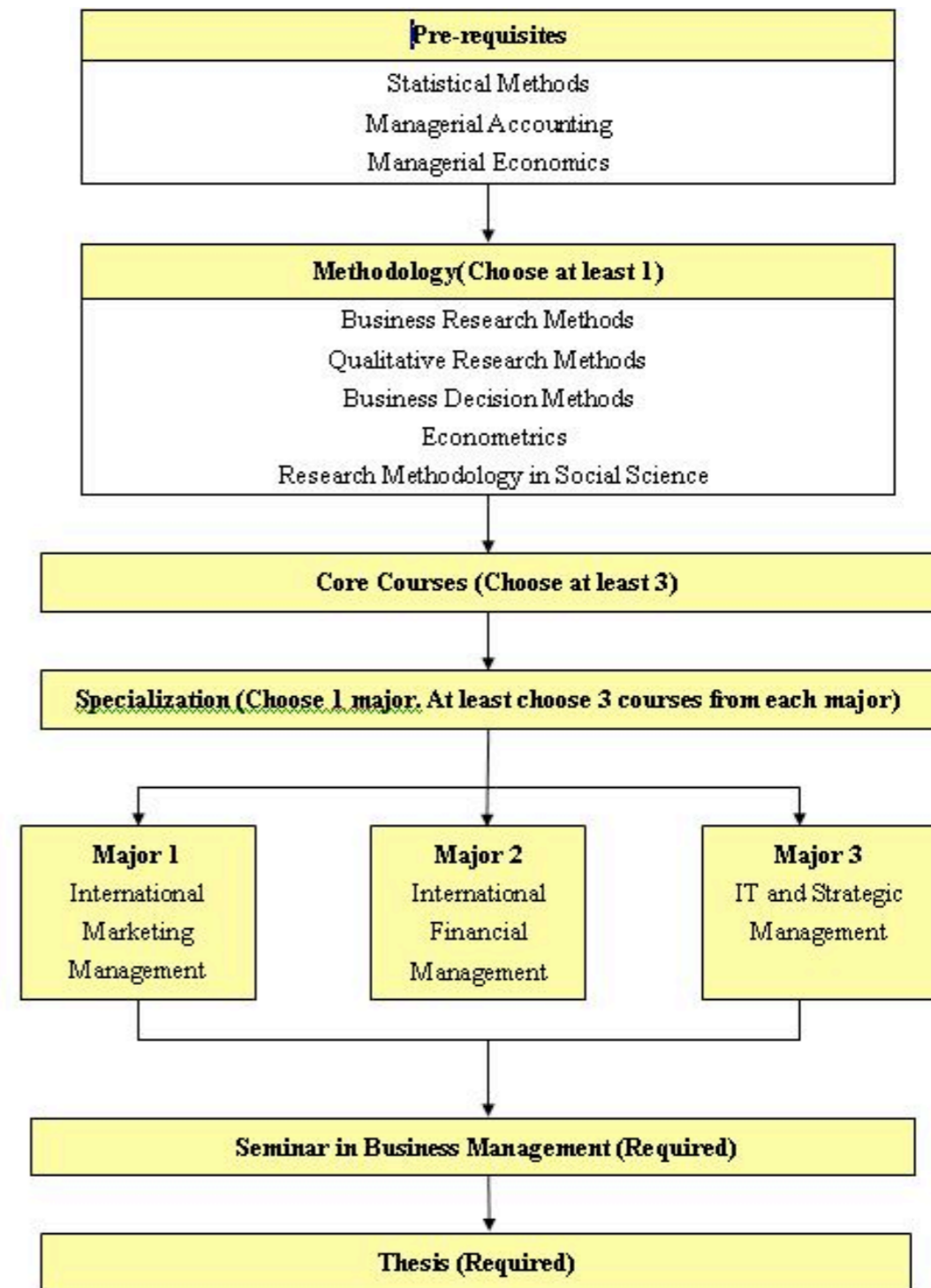
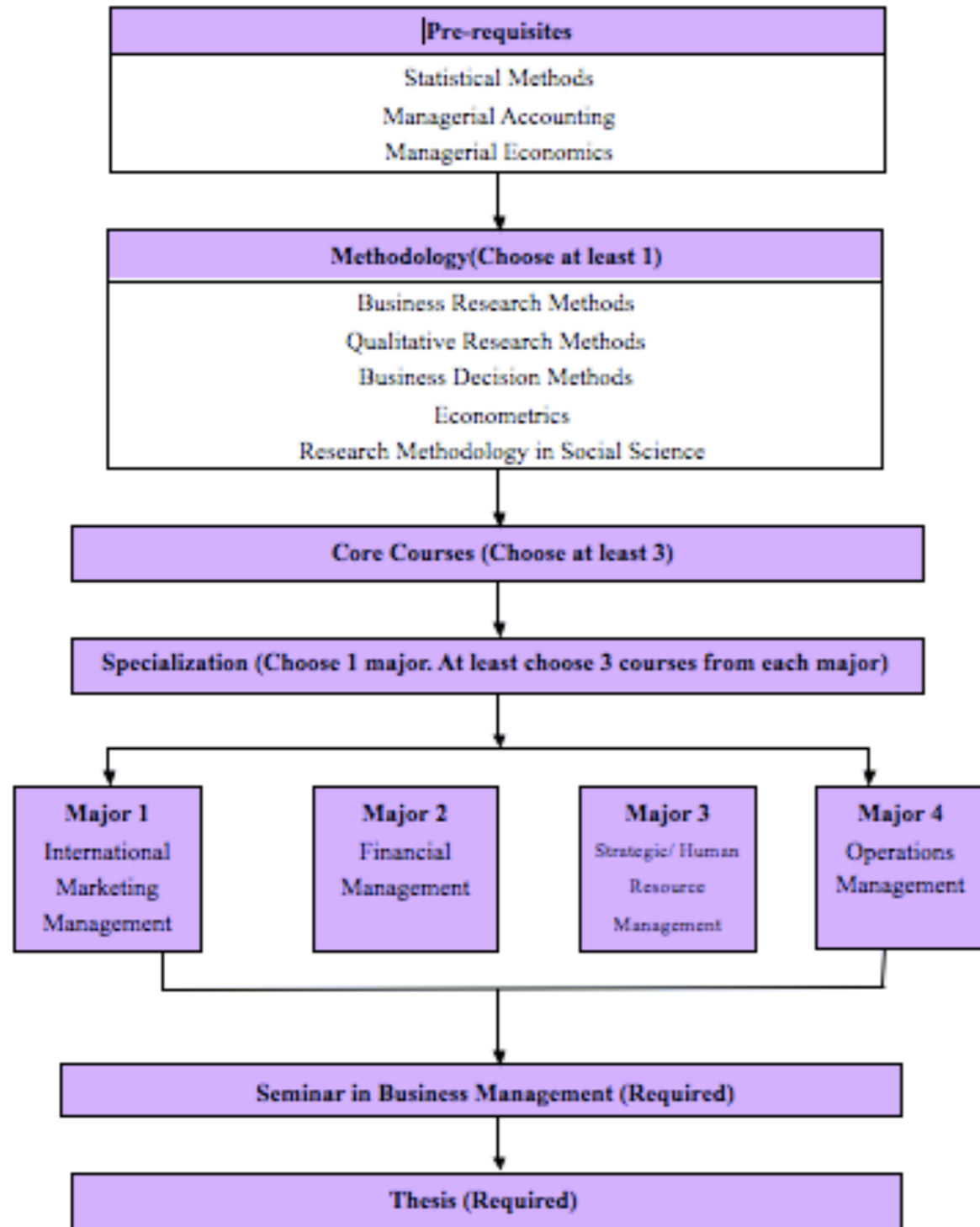
- Because there are 2 different course maps, our class is able to choose from one or the other, but not both.

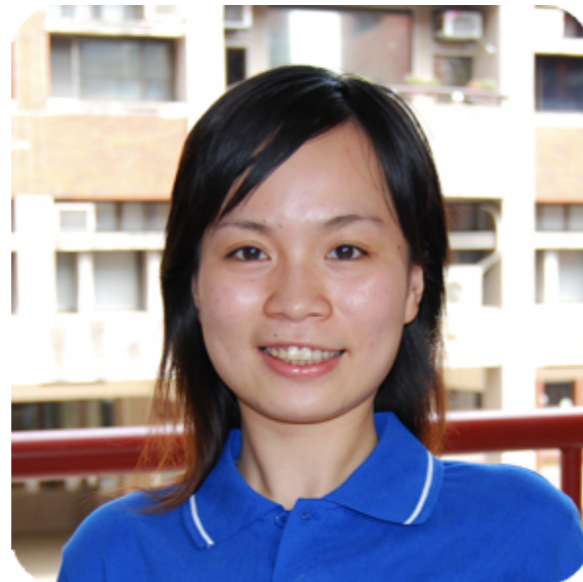
